We Can Play Faster – 10 HST Do's

- 1. Play ready golf. If you get there first, you hit first.
- 2. On the green, the time to line up your putt is *while the player farthest from the hole is putting*. Don't wait. Be ready to go immediately when it's your turn.
- 3. When your group clears the green, get in your carts and *move to the next tee*, **then** enter the scores.
- 4. If you're not scoring, go to the tee immediately and tee off first.
- 5. Putt out. If you're close to the hole and won't be standing in someone's line, don't mark. Putt out.
- 6. Keep moving. Drop your cart partner at his/her ball, then move to your ball and get ready. Don't wait.
- 7. If your ball is 30/40 yds away from your partner, don't sit in the cart. Walk to your ball with a couple of clubs and get ready to hit.
- 8. Always park your cart *behind* the green so golfers on the fairway don't have to wait for you to clear out.
- 9. Don't put clubs away! Get in your cart *with club in hand* and drive away to the next shot. ALWAYS have a club in your hand when you get in the cart. Put one in, take one out. Don't put your club back until you take out the one you will use next.
- 10. If you take off your glove to putt, do so *in advance*. Then, put it back on *before* you reach the next tee box.

Lagniappe: Since a lot of courses are now letting us pull the flagstick, first person to putt out is responsible for replacing the flagstick.
